Applications are invited from academic clinicians with PhD (or equivalent) and preferably post-doctoral experience who are also trained in haematology and/or haemato-pathology (FRCPath or equivalent). This position affords a unique opportunity to develop a translational research programme and develop new molecular approaches to cancer diagnosis alongside the regional Haemato-Oncology Diagnostic Service, serving a population of 4 million. The successful applicant will join an expanding consortium of research groups focusing on normal and malignant haematopoiesis (<http://www.haem.cam.ac.uk>) and will benefit from the outstanding environment for translational cancer research spread across multiple institutions in Cambridge (e.g CRI <http://www.cambridgecancer.org.uk>, CIMR <http://www.cimr.cam.ac.uk>, Sanger Institute <http://www.sanger.ac.uk>). Strong links to the Sanger Institute will particularly facilitate the development of new genetic approaches to diagnosis.

Appointment will be to the retiring age subject to satisfactory completion of a probationary period. Salary scale £74,504 - £100,446 according to the level of seniority. Application will be made to the Addenbrooke's NHS Trust for the award of an Honorary Consultant contract.
